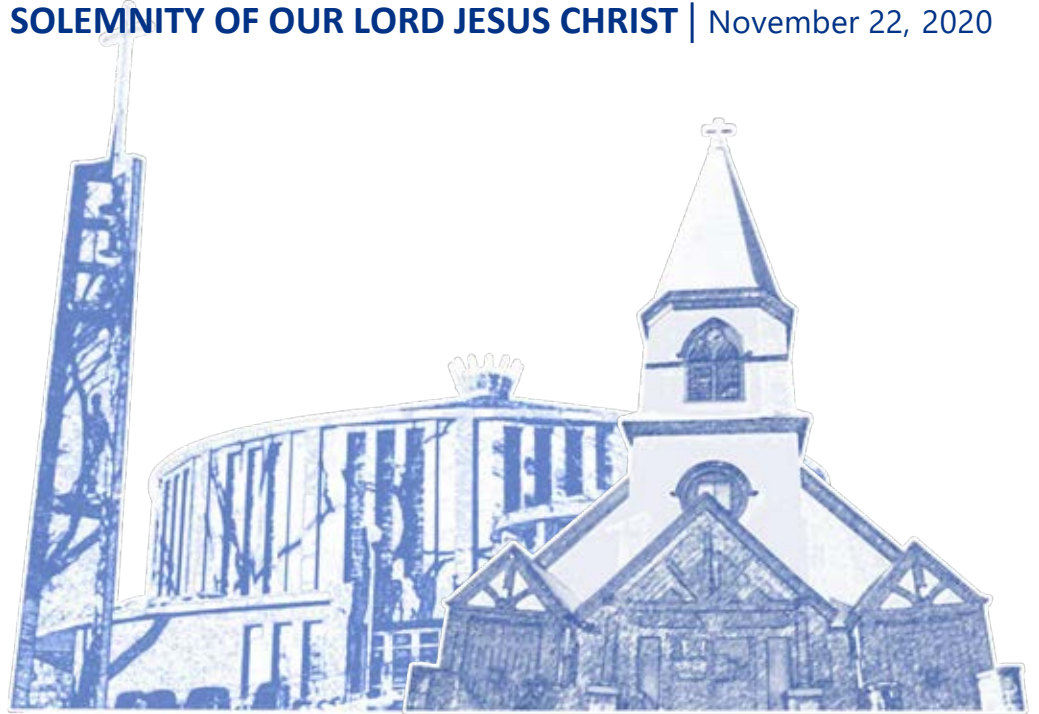

Dear Parishioners:

Please read through the information and consider how you might participate. As the flyer says this is just a pause for this year and we anticipate being back in person next Christmas and reviving this in person experience.
