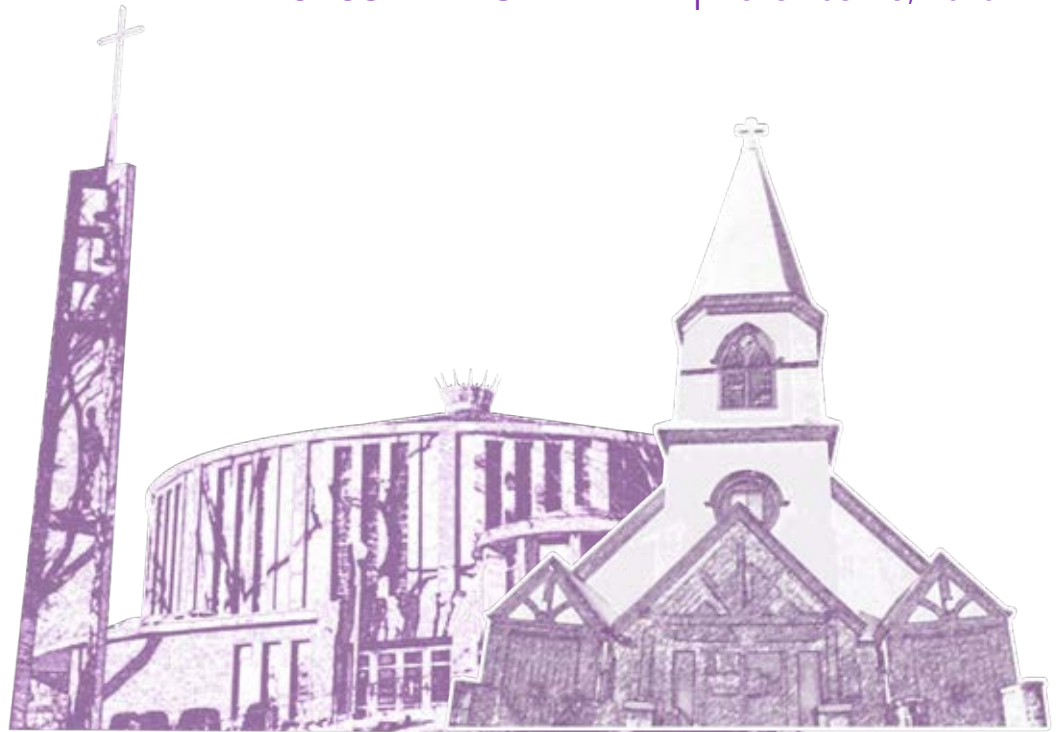

# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners:

Twice during the year we use purple vestments to relay an underlying sense of the season. During Lent the purple signifies the need for repentance and forgiveness. In Advent we use purple again as a symbol of waiting and expectation. The Advent wreath that we light during the season enables us to have a visual countdown to the coming feast.

We are hearing over and over that this holiday season is going to be one that is very unusual. Holiday gatherings and travel plans may have to be sharply curtailed. The ability of people to go out and shop for gifts will also be of concern as we try to avoid crowds. For this reason, we have transitioned our annual 'Giving Tree' to a virtual experience so we can help create a sense of the Christmas spirit for those whose lives have been disproportionately changed by the virus. I realize that many people like the whole process of actually doing in person shopping and picking items out but this year it is not a wise thing to do so we are seeking to use a different method to arrive at the same end-brightening the lives of others.

A special word of thanks to parishioners Lorri Gorman, Mary Henson and Jessica Hynes who came up with an alternative giving plan and put together a user-friendly program for us to use. Great work! Our outreach to veterans is also somewhat different. We are again asking for gift cards (Target, Costco, Walmart, Stop and Shop, Shop Rite). Some of these will be sent to support the work of the Knights of Malta who work with the wounded veterans and their families at Walter Reed. Some will be sent to the Food Pantry at the Veteran's Hospital in Montrose, NY that serves local veterans. These cards should be dropped in the collection basket during Mass or sent to the church office at either OLPH or St. Catharine.

We are all going to have to try very hard to make this Christmas the best it can be under the circumstances. We are presently still operating with a limited seating availability and I expect that to be in place for Christmas. Attendance at Mass will have to be limited. Those limits will be strictly enforced for the health, safety and well-being of all. Exact details will be announced as the date approaches and as I get final numbers from the Archdiocese in terms of capacity. It should be understood that people with underlying conditions or who are in frail health should think seriously about if they should attend.

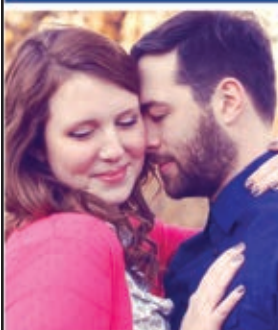
